



IASGP Travel Grants for Düsseldorf Graduate Conference on Party Research (GraPa)

The IASGP supports a limited number of participants wanting to take part in the annual graduate conference of the Düsseldorf Party research Institute PRUF (GraPa).

The **conditions** are as follows:

- The paper should deal with German speaking countries, but this may be as part of a comparative analysis.
- Selection will be based on the quality of the paper proposal. Proposals from regions that are not normally well-represented at the GraPa will be especially welcome but we are open to high quality proposals from anywhere.
- Applicants need to document that they cannot obtain funding from other sources (e.g. a letter signed by the PhD supervisor or head of department).
- Recipients are expected to join the IASGP. Graduate membership costs £8 per annum.

Procedure:

The application for financial support should be submitted together with the application for the GraPa and contain an estimate of the expected travel costs, an abstract and a letter of recommendation by the PhD supervisor.

The IASGP will not always be able to cover all costs.

Amounts per participant:

a) Germany outside Düsseldorf / Cologne / Bonn (i.e. beyond commuter distance): £150 maximum

b) Europe outside Germany: £350

c) Outside Europe: £1500 maximum
